ABOUT OUR DANCE SEASON

We are so excited to start our 8th dance season! This year our studio theme is "THE OSCARS". Join us as we dance to award winning movie soundtracks. Each class will dance to a different movie and perform 2 routines at our end of the year Showcase. Our season runs from August to May. Classes are held once a week. Dancers meet on the same day every week for their class. They are scheduled 34 weeks of instruction, and guaranteed 32 weeks. 2 weeks are scheduled as extra weeks in case of closing due to weather or any other emergency. Tuition is conveniently split into 9 monthly payments starting in August for easier transactions. FIRST WEEK OF CLASS IS A TRAIL CLASS. Dancers are welcome to try a class the first week at no charge before deciding what to enroll in. If dancer decides to stay in class, tuition will begin for August. Final tuition payment is due in April. Showcase is the first weekend in May.

PAYMENTS

TUITION PAYMENT IS DUE ON THE 1st OF THE MONTH

- Payments can be made by cash, check, card, or you can register for Auto Pay on the DSP app
- LATE FEE added after 15 days. Returned checks will incur a \$36 Service fee
- Costumes and Showcase fees are NOT included in yearly tuition.
- Yearly tuition is not refundable if dancer drops after 6 weeks.

WHAT TO *expect*

FIRST DAY OF CLASS

On your first day of class, plan to arrive a few minutes early to stop by the front desk for any questions. Classes will be labeled on the doors. We will show your dancer where to put bags & shoes, find the restrooms, and introduce teachers before class begins. 1 Parent is welcome the first week of class. After that our dance classes are students & teachers only. Parents are welcome to drop off dancers or wait in our lobby.

DRESS CODE

Your dancers dress code will depend on the style of class they are in. The first few weeks of class your dance instructor will go over all dress code guidelines. There is also an overall dress code guide attached. We recommend having the correct shoes by the 4th week of class. If your dancer ever forgets to wear the correct shoes please still bring them to class as they can wear socks or go barefoot for that day. Our dancewear store is also open to size and order the perfect outfit or shoes for your dancer!

dress code

BALLET / TAP COMBO CLASSES AGES 3-7

Any dance leotard or leotard dress. Pink or Tan footed tights
Pink Ballet shoes - Please wait to order tap shoes until costumes have been chosen.
Hair must be pulled up and out of face.

CLASSICAL BALLET TECHNIQUE CLASSES & POINTE

Black dance leotard or leotard dress. Ballet Pink footed tights (Convertible for Pointe)
Pink canvas Ballet shoes. Pointe Shoes must be purchased with approval at a dancewear store.
Hair must be in a ballet bun.

JAZZ CLASSES -ALL AGES

Dance leotard or sports top and leggings/shorts. Tan footed tights
Tan Jazz Shoes
Hair must be pulled up and out of face

LYRICAL/ CONTEMPORARY CLASSES-

Dance leotard or sports top and leggings/shorts.
Tan footless Tights,
Lyrical half soles or no shoes - Review with teacher
Hair must be pulled up and out of face

dress code

HIP HOP CLASSES

Comfortable loose attire. Gym wear or sports top with leggings /shorts. No jeans or dresses. Sneakers or tennis shoes used in class only. No crocs or sandals
Hair must be pulled up and out of face

TUMBLE CLASSES

Dance or Gymnastics Leotard. Shorts or leggings suggested. No tights.
barefoot or check shoe with instructors
hair must be pulled up and out of face .

STRENGTH TRAINING

Leotard or dancewear. Tights not required
Jazz shoes or barefoot.
Information on equipment required for class will be given on the first week by instructor
Hair must be pulled up and out of face

COMPANY CLASSES

Company dancers are required to wear JDA uniform. Dancers that do not have uniform yet, may wear all black dance attire. Please check with instructor for correct shoes.

WHAT ARE MY NEXT *steps?*

REGISTERED FOR CLASSES? Here's what happens next

- ☐ Classes start Monday August 12th. 1 spectator is welcome.
- ☐ First week is a trial week, if your dancer chooses not to stay please let the front desk know.
- ☐ If your dancer loves the class and chooses to stay, please remember August tuition is due by the 30th.
- ☐ Please place the order for your dancers correct shoes by the 2nd week of class at our dancewear store.
- ☐ If you would like to enroll in AutoPay please do so by August 26th on the DSP app
- ☐ Don't forget to sign up to receive studio text messages at the front desk.
- ☐ Remember! Our season runs until May 2024. Please keep your dancers class day/time in mind before signing up for other extracurricular activities/programs. Good attendance helps us give your dancer the best instruction possible. If your dancer is unable to attend class for any reason, just give the studio a call!

FREQUENTLY *asked questions*

1. When does the new season start? When does it end?

Our season runs from August 12 - May 3rd

2. I missed open house, can I still register my dancer?

Yes! Our online registration opens on Tuesday July 30th for classes that do not fill up. We keep taking new registrations until August 30th. After August 30th your dancer will have to wait until the following season to register.

3. The class my dancer wanted is full, do you have a waitlist ?

Yes! We have a waitlist if the class you wanted is full, however we do recommend choosing a different class in case your dancer is not able to get in.

4. My dancer is not 3 yet, can they still enroll?

Although we would love to have your tiny superstar, dancers must be 3 and potty trained by July 1st of that season.

FREQUENTLY *asked questions*

5. What if the class my dancer wants is not for her age group?

If the class is off by a few months, we will absolutely let your dancer try it, however we do our best to put together the age groups we feel are best for the classes. If your dancer tries a class and is not ready, your instructor may ask you to swap classes.

6. What if my dancer wants to try more than one class?

Your dancer is welcome to try as many classes as they want the first week at no charge to help them find the perfect class. We do recommend dancers be 5 years or older before enrolling in more than 2 classes.

7. If we miss class can we make it up on a different day?

Our classes are customized for each group and all follow unique and different lesson plans. Since each class learns a different dance it would not be possible for your dancer to get the correct lesson in a different class.

8. Can we order dance shoes at the studio?

Absolutely! Our dancewear store is there to help you find the perfect dance outfit and size your dancer for shoes. Orders are placed every other Friday and typically take 1-3 weeks to arrive.
